When the U. S. Bicentennial was held fifty years ago, WRL and allied organizations launched the Continental Walk for Disarmament and Social Justice, connecting the demands for disarmament and redirected military spending with movements for social justice. Thousands of people walked throughout the country for nine months,



culminating in Washington, DC where for three days we rallied, celebrated and walked to the Pentagon, and the White House.
